

Admissions Agreement

The International Baccalaureate is a comprehensive program with a rigorous curriculum designed for the academically able student who has the potential to earn the International Baccalaureate Diploma. For a student to be prepared for the rigors of the IB program and the externally validated examinations, it is imperative that he/she be a consistent, dedicated learner. Therefore, the Academy of Richmond County requires the following commitment to be made.

I agree to the following terms and conditions for participating in each PDP and/or IB class in which I am enrolled. I will:

1. Follow the rules of the Academy of Richmond County as outlined in the Student Handbook, the Richmond County Code of Student Conduct and Discipline, and the IB Honor Code.
2. Actively participate in class daily by being prepared, listening attentively, offering relevant comments, posing insightful questions, taking notes, etc. In summary, I agree to meet the expectations set forth for each class.
3. Work seriously to improve my composition skills, which involves writing, editing, rewriting, and asking for assistance outside the class period.
4. Schedule medical appointments outside of school when possible and trips for recreation during school holidays.
5. Submit quality work in a timely fashion.
6. Maintain an overall 80 grade point average in core academic PDP classes.
7. Manifest the highest degree of academic integrity. Direct or indirect cheating is grounds for immediate removal from the program. I agree to follow the Honor Code of the Academy of Richmond County.
8. Agree to enroll in and continuously pursue the Full IB Diploma throughout my career of ARC.
9. Remain in the program unless released by recommendation of the IB Dean and Staff.
Continuance in the IB program will be determined by student progress, attitude and motivation.

I understand that if I do not meet the standards of the Pre-DP/IB program, because of the quality of my work, my performance as a serious learner or the failure of any class, I may be asked to withdraw from the program. I will be enrolled in a course of study which better suits my level of performance at my zoned school.
