1. Complete the entire application, paying close attention to the last page before signing.
2. Obtain three (3) current teachers' recommendations to submit with your application. Please refer to the recommendation form provided.
3. Include a copy of your academic transcripts/ report card. In order to apply you must have an 80 or higher in 8th Grade Math.
4. The two hour writing and math assessments and interview will take place at 9 am on the following Saturdays: February 6 and February 13. Please select **one** of these dates and write it in the box at the **top right corner on the Personal Data** page (page 2) of the application and on the **space provided at the bottom of this form**. Detach the bottom of this form and keep it on your refrigerator as a reminder.
5. Inform your guidance counselor you are completing this application. He/she will alert you to any application deadlines you must meet at your school. Remember applications must be submitted on or before Friday, January 29, 2010.
6. If you are accepted in the program, you will be contacted by mail in late March.
7. There will be two Open House/Informational meetings for prospective students and parents:
